ISF / 10+2 FILING

What is the flow of information for 10+2 / ISF filings?

BDG has developed an integrated ISF system in order to maintain the data and keep accurate records.

Technically, the ISF filing needs to be completed 24 hours prior to laden on board. In order to understand how this affects the importer and supplier the date has to be worked backwards.

EXAMPLE:

1. Vessel sails:
Saturday, Feb 07th, 2009
2. Lading date:
Friday, Feb 06th, 2009
3. 24 hour ISF filing requirements
Saturday, Feb 05th, 2009
4. Date that ocean line will need ISF filing confirmation number to stage cargo:
Wednesday, Feb 04th, 2009 (this is a guess)
5. Date that Overseas agent will need documents in order to make ISF filing:
Monday, Feb 02nd, 2009

The week in between we are planning for corrections that need to be made, and question & answer time.

6. Date that overseas agent will need to be notified for the booking.
Monday, Jan 26th, 2009
